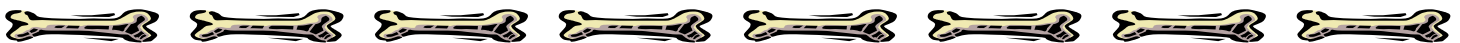
\$75/session for each human/dog team (\$25 for each additional human or dog)

Not only does this method work well for the general public, but also this method is especially beneficial for people with physical ailments (e.g., neck, back, shoulder, arm, or hand injuries) who can get hurt physically correcting or do not have the strength to physically correct.
